

AUTHOR GUIDELINES

Scope

IDP Working Papers publishes papers in the field of public law, particularly on the priority areas of the Public Law Observatory at the University of Barcelona: Autonomous Communities and Federalism, Government and Local Law, Digital Society, Migration Law, European Union Law, Gender and Environmental Law. However, papers in the field of public law in the broadest sense will also be considered.

Authors

Contributions from researchers or scholars from any university or research centre are welcome. We particularly encourage contributions from visiting researchers or lecturers at the Observatory of Public Law or the Faculty of Law of the University of Barcelona, as well as PhD students at the University of Barcelona's Faculty of Law.

Submission of Manuscripts

Proposals for working papers should be sent to a idp@ub.edu

The proposal will go through a light peer-review process to ensure it meets quality standards. Once received, the proposal will be assessed by the editorial team, who may reject it or send it for evaluation by a member of the Public Law Observatory. The outcome of this evaluation may be acceptance for publication, acceptance subject to revisions, or refusal. This process should not take more than two months from the date of reception of the proposal.

Approved proposals will be published in the IDP Working Papers series and will be distributed through the Public Law Observatory's social media channels. The series is hosted in the University of Barcelona's Digital Repository (<https://hdl.handle.net/2445/228514>) and is indexed in Dialnet.

Originality

Proposal texts must be original and must not contain plagiarism or self-plagiarism. Authors must avoid the use of artificial intelligence systems for content generation. Their use is permitted in a supporting role, although the scope of such use must always be explicitly stated.

Length

It is recommended that proposals range between 5,000 and 8,000 words, including the bibliography and footnotes, but excluding any annexes.

Format

It is recommended to use the template provided. However, the text must be submitted in Garamond 12, single-spaced with standard margins. The bibliography must be in APA 7th ed. format (<https://crai.ub.edu/serveis-i-recursos/asesorament-referencies-bibliografiques/estil-apa>) and must be referenced in footnotes and in the references section.

Working paper structure

Submitted manuscripts should, preferably, follow the format set out below:
